- HIV testing

Facts

- Each year, over 2 million HIV-infected pregnant women give birth to 700,000 HIV-infected infants.
- The life expectancy of infected babies is three years.
- A single dose of nevirapine given to the mother and infant could prevent 350,000 infant infections each year.
